  - Increase in threat trends and calls
    - 400 threats in 2018, vs 770 this year already
  - O What is our role to ensure safe schools and communities?
    - Team effort
    - No jokes of violence are ok
    - Notice changes in child's demeanor or grades
    - Monitor child's social media
      - Have a friend/close family member monitor the social media
      - 1 833 MDBESAFE
        - Phone in tips or concerns
        - Cyber bullying should always be reported
  - If we are in crisis

- Sit still (stay home) and do not phone the school
- DO NOT text or call student
  - Noises can be a large danger if armed assailant in school
- School will update with emails, FB groups, social media
- o Legislative update
  - Voted against appointed members of the BOE, as we would rather have them elected
- o Per Dr. Edoho-Eket
  - Meeting consistently with staff to go over safety plan
  - Doing best to be prepared for emergencies
  - Since we are the largest elementary school there is a lot of logistics
