 - https://www.ptachc.org/ Thursday, 10/10/24, |7 PM 8 PM: comprehensive virtual session on PT(S)A Advocacy 101, designed to empower PT(S)A members with the knowledge and tools to effectively advocate for our students and schools.
 - https://www.ptachc.org/wp-content/uploads/2024/10/OCTOBER-2024-PTACHC-LEGIS LATIVE.pdf Legislative Update in re new policy for cel phone use in schools. One suggestion is that parents take more responsibility. District is open to other suggestions.
 - Legislative meeting was attended by government representatives including MD State Senators Katie Frye Hester and Clarence Lam. They presented priorities for next session, including approval of mental health funding in Maryland (\$5-6 million to Howard County). Expenditure gaps discussed as a result of the increase in cost of construction; schools have not been built to support previous housing growth.
