REPORTS FROM WES PTA EXECUTIVE BOARD

• Ben Bach (PTACHC Representative):

- Update on PTACHC voting-Positions on Proposed Legislation:
 - HoCo 2-25: PTACHC supports a BOE Compensation Commission as long as there is no additional cost to it. PTACHC opposes a change to term limits.
 - HoCo 3-25: PTACHC supports Public Campaign Financing for BOE candidates. He abstained.
 - HoCo 11-25: PTACHC supports a max severance for HoCo superintendent position (no more than 4 weeks per year of service)
 - HoCo 15-25: PTACHC took no position on this piece of proposed legislation for the BOE to study how to best detect weapons in schools
 - HoCo 10-25: PTACHC took no position on this piece of proposed legislation to make certain school holidays mandatory.
 - MD State House Bill 38: PTACHC opposes this bill takes control away from the county to manage APFO committees.
 - BOE Public Hearings on Budget 2026 on 1/30 and 2/10.
