6:30 PM: Call to order by Mrs. Girardi (President).

Reports from School Administration

- Update from Mrs. Brown (Principal)
 - Expressed appreciation to the PTA for their ongoing support.
 - Reported an excellent turnout for the Turkey Trot and noted it was a successful event. Reminded families that parent-teacher conference scheduling closes tomorrow.
 - Thanked the PTA for providing staff dinner during conferences. Announced two half-days next Monday and Tuesday, followed by school closure for students for the remainder of the week.
 - Shared that American Education Week has been enjoyable, and the staff appreciated the positive feedback and recognition from families.
- Update from Mrs. Santoni (Assistant Principal)

- Congratulated everyone on the successful Turkey Trot and shared enjoyment in participating as the turkey.
- Reminded families to send students with coats, gloves, and hats as the weather gets colder.
- Clarified **smartwatch** expectations: devices must remain in **school mode**, and students may not use them to contact parents during the school day. Students who need to reach parents may do so through the school office.
- Announced that **CogAT testing** for 3rd graders will take place in **December**; scores impact 4th-grade math placement and middle-school course placement. No preparation is needed beyond a good night's sleep and a healthy breakfast.
- Update from Mrs. Haddaway (Teacher Liaison)
 - Noted that kindergarten students were especially excited to participate and support their class feathers.
 - Mrs. Girardi: Thanked teachers for assisting with Turkey Trot feather activities in their classrooms.
